Location: park, large garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 12 m | **Width:** 8 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: tulip-shaped, striking, standing, singular, big, unpleasantly scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, big, polished, slightly hairy | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, large, cones | **Fruit colour:** red-violet | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown, violet, green | **Twigs:** bare
