Location: park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, cemetery, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Eco planting, Landscape planting

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, humans, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates heat

Flowers: bowl-shaped, striking, singular | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green, buds pale green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, lanceolate, matt polished, hairy, serrate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow, yellow-brown, yellow-orange | **Fruits:** striking, rich fruit yield, edible, large | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** hairy, thickly branched | **Root system:** deep
