TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, shade trees | **Topiary on stem:** roof-trained

USE

Location: park, large garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 10 m | **Width:** 8 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: discrete, small | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, big, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** pale grey | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** pale brown | **Twigs:** bare
