TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees, characteristic trees, fruit trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** roof-trained, pollard, multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: square, park, large garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 15 m | **Width:** 6 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, small mammals, humans | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: spikes, discrete, singular | **Flower colour:** green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, polished | **Autumn colour:** pale yellow | **Fruits:** edible, raspberry-like | **Fruit colour:** white, red, black | **Bark colour:** pale grey | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** pale brown | **Twigs:** bare
