Tree types: standard trees, shade trees | **Topiary on stem:** roof-trained

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded, pyramidal, wide pyramidal | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 6 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness
