Crown shape: wide oval | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 3 - 9 m | **Width:** 3 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, palmate, big, serrate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** edible, small, raspberry-like | **Fruit colour:** wine red | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** spiral | **Twig colour:** brown
