TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 9 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds

Flowers: corymbose, discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid | **Autumn colour:** orange-red, red, red-violet | **Fruits:** discrete, drupe | **Fruit colour:** blue-black | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare
