TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** beehive, globe, cylinder, multi-stem umbrella, espalier, pleached | **Topiary:** globe, hedge element, pleached

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 5 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: umbels, striking, singular | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** red-green, buds red | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovate, narrow, polished, smooth | **Fruits:** discrete, berry | **Fruit colour:** black | **Bark colour:** green, grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** green, grey
