**Location:** park, central reservation, large garden, small garden

**Height:** 3 - 5 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 7B

**Wind:** tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 4, pollen value 4

**Flowers:** umbels, singular | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green, underside yellow-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, leathery, polished, underside hairy | **Autumn colour:** yellow, yellow-orange | **Fruits:** striking, edible, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** grey | **Twig colour:** red-brown
