Location: park, central reservation, large garden, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** very dry, dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, owls, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside yellow-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, long needles | **Fruits:** cones | **Fruit colour:** pale brown | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** orange, brown | **Twigs:** bare
