TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, conifers | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 10 - 15 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, owls, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, long needles | **Fruits:** cones | **Fruit colour:** pale brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** pale brown | **Twigs:** bare
