Flowers: discrete | Flower colour: yellow | Flowering period: May - June | Leaf colour: blue-green, underside grey-green | Leaves: evergreen, needles or scales, long needles | Fruits: large, cones | Fruit colour: orange, brown | Bark colour: grey | Bark: peeling, smooth, later on rough | Twig colour: grey-brown, green | Twigs: bare
