Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, conifers | **Topiary:** beehive

USE

Location: park, large garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 15 - 20 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, owls, small mammals

Flowers: discrete | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** grey-blue | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, short needles | **Fruits:** large, cones | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-black | **Bark:** peeling, smooth | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare
