Tree types: multi-stemmed trees, conifers, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, large garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 5 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, owls, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, long needles, scented | **Fruits:** cones | **Fruit colour:** pale brown | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** peeling, furrowed | **Twig colour:** orange, brown | **Twigs:** bare
