Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Prairie planting

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2 - 6 m | **Width:** 1.5 - 4.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: bowl-shaped, striking, singular, big, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green, buds pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, crenate, ternate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, edible, drupe | **Fruit colour:** yellow | **Bark colour:** green | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** thorned
