Location: park, central reservation, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 12 - 18 m | **Width:** 10 - 15 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8A

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, half filled, small, scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, orange-red | **Fruits:** small, cherry | **Fruit colour:** red, black | **Bark colour:** brown-violet | **Bark:** peeling, smooth, later on rough, striped | **Twig colour:** grey-brown, red-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, central root
