Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, feathered trees, characteristic trees, fruit trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella | **Topiary:** espalier

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 8 m | **Width:** 5 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, humans, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: striking, singular, scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, edible, plum | **Fruit colour:** yellow-orange | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
