TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, feathered trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees, characteristic trees, fruit trees, woodland planting stock, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Eco planting, Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded, wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 15 - 25 m | **Width:** 10 - 15 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, striking, singular | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** matt green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** striking, edible, cherry | **Fruit colour:** dark red, black | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** smooth, striped | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels, horizontal branches | **Root system:** deep, extensive, highly branched, coarse roots, tap root
