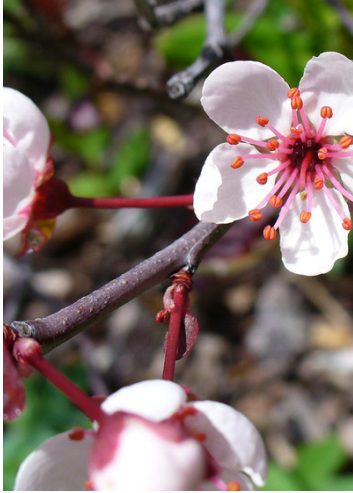

TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3B - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: singular, small, scented | **Flower colour:** pale pink | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** violet | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, serrate | **Autumn colour:** brown, violet | **Fruits:** small, cherry | **Fruit colour:** dark violet | **Bark colour:** black | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** black | **Twigs:** bare
