Location: park, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: ovoid | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, humans, nectar value 3, pollen value 3

Flowers: striking, singular | **Flower colour:** white-pink | **Flowering period:** March - March | **Leaf colour:** green, buds pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, polished, serrate | **Autumn colour:** orange-red | **Fruits:** striking, edible, nut, drupe | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
