**Tree types:** standard trees

### USE

**Location:** street, park, central reservation, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** narrow oval | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 10 m | **Width:** 3 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 7A

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

**Flowers:** singular, small | **Flower colour:** pink | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** small, cherry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
