### TYPES OF PLANTING

**Tree types:** multi-stemmed trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

### USE

**Location:** park, central reservation, in containers, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting, Prairie planting

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 5 - 15 m | **Width:** 5 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** intolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

### PLANTKENMERKEN

**Flowers:** raceme, star-shaped, striking, standing, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, leathery, polished, scented with contusion, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, yellow-orange | **Fruits:** small, drupe | **Fruit colour:** dark red, black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown, black | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough, striped | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare
