Location: avenue, square, park, central reservation, in containers, large garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: weeping | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4 - 5 m | **Width:** 5 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral

Flowers: raceme, rosette-shaped, striking, small | **Flower colour:** pale pink, dark pink | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, doubly serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey-brown, black | **Bark:** deeply furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** hairy
