Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** pyramid, cone, multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 7 m | **Width:** 3 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies

Flowers: raceme, striking, singular | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** red-violet, buds bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, serrate | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** toxic, small, cherry | **Fruit colour:** red-violet | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** violet | **Twigs:** bare
