TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** roof-trained, vase, multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 10 m | **Width:** 6 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerates heat

Flowers: striking, singular, scented | **Flower colour:** white-pink | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, orange-red | **Fruits:** discrete, drupe | **Fruit colour:** black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** striped | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** deep, highly branched, tap root
