**Tree types:** standard trees, half-stem trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, fruit trees

### USE

**Location:** park, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 7 m | **Width:** 4 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7B - 11B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** intolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds, small mammals, humans

### PLANTKENMERKEN

**Flowers:** infundibular, singular, stuffed | **Flower colour:** deep red | **Flowering period:** July - August | **Leaf colour:** bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, leathery, polished | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** striking, edible, pear | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare
