Tree types: standard trees, climate trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: street, avenue, park, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Climate planting, Eco planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: ovoid | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 5 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** very dry, dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

Flowers: corymbose, small | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, polished | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, red-violet | **Fruits:** discrete, small, drupe | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling, slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** thorned
