**Tree types:** standard trees, feathered trees, shade trees

### USE

**Location:** street, avenue, park, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** narrow pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 8 - 12 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

**Flowers:** raceme, striking | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, wide, polished | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, red-violet | **Fruits:** discrete, small, drupe | **Fruit colour:** red-brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling, slightly furrowed, smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** thorned
