Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray

Flowers: catkins, discrete, pendulous | **Flower colour:** yellow-brown | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** buds yellow, yellow-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, dentate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** orange-red, scarlet | **Fruits:** acorn | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** pale brown, green
