Location: street, avenue, square, car park / parking lot, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

Crown shape: columnar | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 15 - 20 m | **Width:** 5 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: catkins, discrete, pendulous | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, polished, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** striking, raceme, acorn | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** deeply furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare, vertical branches | **Root system:** deep, tap root
