Tree types: standard trees, shade trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 8 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: catkins, discrete, pendulous | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, narrow, dissected, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** striking, raceme, acorn | **Fruit colour:** cinnamon-brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels | **Root system:** deep, central root
