Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 10 - 11 m | **Width:** 5 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** very dry, dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, corymbose, papilionaceous, striking, pendulous, big, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** pale pink | **Flowering period:** June - August | **Leaf colour:** bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, pinnate, Nitrogen fixing | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, pod | **Fruit colour:** red-brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** deeply furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** slightly thorned | **Root system:** shallow, extensive, roots push up surface,
