Flowers: rosette-shaped, singular, small, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** white, red | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** buds red, blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, narrow, dentate, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, orange-red | **Fruits:** edible, small, thorned, hips | **Fruit colour:** red-brown | **Bark colour:** green | **Twig colour:** dark red | **Twigs:** thorned
