Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** all soils | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** very dry, dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees

Flowers: singular, small, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, small, leaf thorns, dentate, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** small, thorned, hips | **Fruit colour:** black-violet | **Bark colour:** red | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** violet, green | **Twigs:** thorned
