TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 12 m | **Width:** 5 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, papilionaceous, pendulous, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** June - June | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, leaf thorns, pinnate, Nitrogen fixing | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, pod | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** deeply furrowed, spiral | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** thorned, zigzagging, vertical branches | **Root system:** shallow, extensive, tap root, clinging aerial roots
