Location: park, central reservation, countryside, ecological zone, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Eco planting, Landscape planting, Climate planting, Prairie planting

Height: 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.0 - 8.0) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

Flowers: singular, small, scented | **Flower colour:** pink-red | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, small, leaf thorns, scented with contusion, dentate, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** small, thorned, hips | **Fruit colour:** orange-red | **Bark colour:** red, green | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** thorned | **Root system:** deep, extensive
