USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, cemetery, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 5 - 8 m | **Width:** 1 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** peaty, light clay, sand | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet, very wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline

Flowers: catkins | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** February - March | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, pendant | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** small, catkins | **Fruit colour:** yellow | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
