USE

Location: central reservation, large garden, small garden, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** food forest

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 3 - 7 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: umbels, unpleasantly scented | **Flower colour:** pale pink | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** buds violet, violet-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, scented with confusion, serrate, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** edible, berry, drupe | **Fruit colour:** black-violet | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** red, violet
