USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting, Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 0.5 - 0.75 m | **Width:** 0.2 - 0.3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.1 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: spikes, standing | **Flower colour:** violet, blue-violet | **Flowering period:** June - September | **Leaf colour:** grey-green, underside felty white | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, scented | **Autumn colour:** brown | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Twig colour:** violet, green | **Twigs:** thornless | **Root system:** shallow, extensive
