Crown shape: wide oval | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 5 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution
