## USE

**Location:** park, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant, Prairie planting

**Crown shape:** narrow pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 30 - 55 m | **Width:** 5 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 10A

## ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness
