TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, climate trees, woodland planting stock | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: street, square, car park / parking lot, park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Climate planting, Landscape planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 9 - 12 m | **Width:** 7 - 9 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, small mammals | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, striking, singular | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** pale green, underside felty white | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, serrate, crenate | **Autumn colour:** pale yellow | **Fruits:** striking, raceme, berry | **Fruit colour:** orange-red | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** deep, shallow, central root
