**Location:** street, avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting, Eco planting

**Height:** 0.5 - 1 m | **Width:** 1 - 1.8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 7B

**Wind:** tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (5.5 - 7.0) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 3, pollen value 0 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

**Flowers:** corymbose | **Flower colour:** white, yellow-green | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, lacinate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, yellow-orange, orange-red, red-brown | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, extensive, highly branched
