USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, windbreak | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant, Eco planting

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 2 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, spikes, bell-shaped, discrete | **Flower colour:** white-green, pink | **Flowering period:** May - September | **Leaf colour:** green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, slightly hairy, lobate | **Fruits:** striking, drupe | **Fruit colour:** white | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey | **Twigs:** hairy
