TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, feathered trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, conifers, woodland planting stock, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** beehive, globe, block, cylinder, pyramid, cone, multi-stem umbrella, pleached | **Topiary:** beehive, globe, bowl, egg-shaped, cylinder, block, column, trapezium, pyramid, cone, hedge, hedge element, archway, bonsai

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 8 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, owls, nectar value 0, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete, small | **Flower colour:** pale orange | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, short needles | **Fruits:** toxic, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** deep, highly branched, fine roots
