TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: characteristic trees, conifers | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 0.5 - 2 m | **Width:** 1 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** pale orange | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green, underside yellow-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, short needles | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** red-brown
