TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: characteristic trees, conifers, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella | **Topiary:** globe, bonsai

USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 2.5 - 3.5 m | **Width:** 2.5 - 3.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: discrete, small | **Flower colour:** pale orange | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, short needles, thick | **Fruits:** striking, toxic, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** peeling, furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
