Tree types: solitary shrubs

#### USE

**Location**: park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, bioswale, coastal area | **Pavement**: none | **Planting concepts**: Prairie planting

#### **CHARACTERISTICS**

Crown shape: vase-shaped | Crown structure: open | Height: 3 - 4 m | Width: 3 - 4 m | Winter hardiness zone: 4A - 13B

# **ASPECTS**

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist | Light requirements: sun | Host plant/forage plant: bees, butterflies | Extreme environments: tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerant to short-term flooding

## **PLANTKENMERKEN**

Flowers: raceme, panicle, striking | Flower colour: pink | Flowering period: July - September | Leaf colour: blue-green | Leaves: deciduous, ovoid, lanceolate, narrow | Fruits: discrete, capsule | Fruit colour: yellow-brown | Bark colour: grey-brown | Bark: slightly furrowed | Twig colour: cinnamon-brown | Twigs: with lenticels, pendulous, finely branched, long shoots | Root system: deep, shallow, extensive, slightly branched
