USE

Location: park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, bioswale, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 3 - 4 m | **Width:** 3 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 13B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerant to short-term flooding

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, panicle, striking | **Flower colour:** pink | **Flowering period:** July - September | **Leaf colour:** blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, lanceolate, narrow | **Fruits:** discrete, capsule | **Fruit colour:** yellow-brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** cinnamon-brown | **Twigs:** with lenticels, pendulous, finely branched, long shoots | **Root system:** deep, shallow, extensive, slightly branched
