TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 3 - 4 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 11B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sand | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** very dry, dry | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, striking | **Flower colour:** pale pink | **Flowering period:** April - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, needles or scales, ovoid, small | **Fruits:** discrete, capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** black | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown
